〔講義の目的〕 Students in this course will have plenty of opportunities to improve their English reading and writing skills. In addition, students will also have many opportunities to share opinions and work together to improve overall understanding of English grammar and conversational elements through the use of graded reading material.			
〔講義の概要〕 Graded readers will be selected by students according to individual interest and level. Students must bring a book to class every day for sustain silent reading. Each week students should choose at least five sentences from their books and copy them into a notebook. Each week in class students should choose one sentence whose grammar they find difficult and write in their notebooks to discuss with classmates and the teacher. Every two weeks students must finish one book, write briefly about it in English or in Japanese, and explain it to classmates in a “Book Talk” every two weeks.			
〔履修上の留意点〕 Reading is the best way to learn new English phrases, to reinforce existing vocabulary and grammar knowledge, and to learn about the world. Make an effort to read a little each day, not cram for an exam and then forget after the exam is over.			
〔到達目標〕 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read at least 12 books and 300 pages in English by the end of the year.</li> <li>• Write at least 20 short freewrites in English on topics of interest by the end of the year.</li> <li>• Increase overall grammar ability by constant repetition and review inside and outside class.</li> </ul>			
〔評価方法〕 Class Participation (10%) / Short writings in class (30%) / Homework (30%) / Graded readers (30%)			
〔教科書〕 (none) Supplementary grammar exercises will be handed out upon request.			
〔補助教材・参考書〕 At least 12 graded readers, Starter or Level 1. One A4 notebook with at least 40 pages.			
〔関連科目〕 Lateness will not be tolerated. 15 minutes late is an absence. 3 times late = 1 absence. Students must come on time and be prepared. Students who are not prepared will lose class participation points.
